## PART 2 MINUTES - CONFIDENTIAL APPENDIX 2 STAFF SALARIES

Clerk outlined the reasons for the suggested increase:

- (1) There was no increase last year due to the chaos triggered by Hazel's sudden illness.
- (2) R Springett has now fallen below the minimum wage
- (3) An increase for R. Springett alone would reduce wage parity
- (4) there needed to be an element of merit award to Mr Glew, in view of his exemplary work.
- (5) We are aware that wages are below outside rates for similar work, and we do not want to lose staff to higher paying bodies

NB: Mr Springett's increase will need to be back dated 4 months to April 2020.to comply with MW rules, and it would be fair to backdate Mr Glew's also

There was considerable discussion before It was agreed to increase Mr Springett by 8% as per the second illustration, and Mr Glew by 10% as per the fourth illustration - Agreed 6 for, 1 against. Clerk will write to each member of Staff with the full reasons for the increases, which will also serve to evidence the reasoning despite these uncertain times

## R Springett

Current gross salary: 1,346.80/month, £16,161.60/annual. Based on a 40 hour week. Currently hourly rate - £8.41 (NB - FY 19/20 UK min wage for UK adults aged 25 years & over £8.21).

FY 20/21 the minimum wage has increased to £8.72 (an increase of £0.51/hour or 6.06%).

(2) £0.20 above minimum wage (current difference): £8.92 (160 hrs/wk) - £1427.20/month, gross £17,126.40.

## B Glew:

Current gross salary £1603.33/month, £19,239.96/annual. Based on a 40 hour week. Current hourly rate - £10.02.

- (4) 10% increase £1763.66/month, £21,163.96/annual. Normally reserved for exceptional employees or those whose salaries are not competitive within the market.
- (ii) Standards. Chairman noted two possible standards complaints received.
- (a) That a BG Cllr had reported Cllr Rayner to KCC Monitoring Officer alleging predetermination of the Landfill HGV application.- The complaint was deemed unfounded.
- (b) That BG Cllr had abused his role by attempting to browbeat a member of the public No evidence yet presented. TMBC Monitoring Officer notified pending.
- (iii) Resident. Chairman reported on Health Visitors difficulty accessing a vulnerable resident's premises. Chairman and his wife, with Mr Glew, Clerk and Cllrs Shaw and Millener all visited and cleared both front & rear gardens.
- (iv) Landfill Site to note the significance of the HGV increase without the necessary lowering of site finished levels that would have allowed the site to be developed within the Local Plan Timeframe.
