Southern Gas Networks Cllr Perry advised of the company's thanks to the residents of Borough Green for their patience and courteous co-operation during the recent road works and traffic control on the A25 Maidstone Rd. The council agreed that the company employees had, in turn, been very considerate and helpful.

159. Potters Mede Grounds

- (i) It is considered that the new management of BGJFC has a much more caring attitude about the pitches. Overseeding carried out by Cllr Willard has taken
- (ii) No further information on a future maintenance programme.
- (iii) Chairman advised that Wrotham Bowls Club expressed an interest in using the new pitch adj. Potters Mede but this is likely to prove too costly for them
- (iv) It is thought that the adjacent landowner, Robert Body, may be able to provide the additional topsoil needed for the new ground. To bring the land up to standard would take 2/3 years.

160. Potters Mede Pavilion

- (i) All Cllrs had received copies of a letter of thanks from a recent hirer for the excellent facilities. Thanks have been expressed to the staff for their diligent work
- (ii) AGREED that spare carpet tiles, received at no cost, can be given to a charity recording studio project in Sevenoaks.

161. Recreation Ground

RESOLVED to accept a quotation from Landscape Services in the sum of £37.88/visit for monthly playground inspections 2015/2016.

162 Mowing 2015

RESOLVED to accept a quotation from Landscape Services for mowing 2015 in the sums of: £80.11/cut Potters Mede and £42.24/cut Recreation Ground

163. Isles Quarry Redevelopment

- (i) Chairman advised that results of the Bourne water sampling during the first phase of piling have been received and it is understood that sampling also took place during the second phase. It is also understood that gardens in phase 1 and 2 of the development are clean and Chairman has liaised with the residents assuring them of this.
- (ii) Chairman will continue to make complaint to the planning authority because there has been no information since October 2014 about possible contamination of phases 3 & 4
- (iii) All Cllrs had received copies of a reply from T&MBC Chief Executive regarding the formal complaint lodged by BGPC and subsequent e-mail correspondence with the Chairman. There was some discussion about comments in the Chief Executive's reply which contradict recent letters from T&MBC Planning. Further options open to BGPC were considered but it was AGREED to acknowledge the reply and await the result of the ongoing Independent Standards Investigation of BGPC Chairman.

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164. <u>Commons Act 2006 – Registration of Village Greens: appraisal of inclusions in 2014</u> Supplementary Parish Plan

(i) Possible registration of land at Isles Quarry East including the Thong Lane Bridge was discussed. Chairman advised of rights in view of past use and proposed that IQE be registered as a village green. AGREED that Chairman will collect required evidence.

Further AGREED that Chairman will have informal discussions with Crest Homes about the future management of open space land at IQE and south and west areas of Isles Quarry West.

(ii) No further information on the Borough Green 2014 Supplementary Parish Plan.

165. Community Right to Bid

- (i) Chairman advised that the application for the Henry Simmonds PH has been validated but not yet decided by T&MBC
- (ii) Chairman advised that the applications for the Black Horse and Hoodens and the former Red Lion PH have not yet been submitted and will be held for the time being.

166. Audit 2014/2015

- (i) All Cllrs had received copies of the 6m internal audit report. Thanks were expressed to the Clerk.
- (ii) Chairman has changed links between the parish council websites and his own community website.
- (iii) RESOLVED that payments made by individual Cllrs for BGPC goods/services required, and then requiring reimbursement at the next PC meeting, will now be restricted to emergency situations only.
- (iv) RESOLVED that if possible, Clerk will set up a BGPC fuel card or account with Brackenhill Service Station, Maidstone Road for all fuel purchases

167. Precept 2015/2016

- (i) All Cllrs had received copies of the 8m budget outturn statement 2014/2015 which was considered and noted
- (ii) All Cllrs had received copies of minutes of the Finance Cttee meeting 24.11.14. After discussion RESOLVED to include:
 - £2,000 for fencing and rent of additional recreational land adj Potters Mede
 - Additional £1,000 for repairs and grounds maintenance, Potters Mede
- (iii) RESOLVED to approve all other Finance Cttee recommendations detailed including a 2% increase for all staff w.e.f 1.4.15: noted that for Clerk this will equate to Sp Pt 35 on the NALC salary scale, which is reviewed nationally from time to time.
- (iv) Financial details are still awaited from T&MBC before the Precept for the next F/Y can be finalised. It is hoped that there will be no increase per Band D property. For further consideration at the next meeting.

168. War Memorial

- (i) Chairman has liaised with Mrs Murray regarding future project meetings
- (ii) A draft design will soon be ready for consultation. Costings are awaited.
- (iii) The site meeting with KCC, landowners of the proposed site j/o Western Rd/Sevenoaks Rd, is still awaited.
- (iv) A volunteer has offered to check/collate names of people to be recorded on the memorial

169. 308/306 Bus Service

- (i) Chairman reported on his meeting with fellow ward members and T&MBC officers to discuss the Parking Review: the re-routing of the 308 bus service is being fully included T&MBCllr Mrs Murray was thanked for her hard work in this connection.
- (ii) Noted that residents have received notification of proposed bus stops in Quarry Hill Road which it was agreed are unnecessary: only a stop at the Quarry Hill roundabout is required.
- (iii) Chairman is liaising with KCC about a grant for a possible bus shelter at the above location.
- (iv) Cllr Perry will pass details of bus services to Pembury Hospital to Cllr Shaw.
